- (a) Permit is required and needs to be issued by the Town
- (b) Camping is permitted only in the following locations: Don Burnside Park, Three Lakes Municipal Airport
- (c) Camping in the permitted locations is limited to the designated areas only. Fires are permitted only in the designated and placed fire rings. Fires are never permitted at any time at the Airport.
- (d) Camping at Don Burnside Park is permitted only in conjunction with such events and on such dates as approved in advance by the Three Lakes Park Commission.
- (e) There shall be a fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00) per night for camping on town property with funds transferred to the Park Commission for Burnside Park camping and to the airport budget for Airport Camping.
- Upon receipt of a completed camping application the Park Commission at approved events or Town office or Airport (f) Manager/Assistant Manager for the Three Lakes Municipal Airport shall issue a camping permit to the applicant. The permit shall designate on its face the time period for which the permit is valid, the number of persons in the camping party, and the name and address of the person who applied for the camping permit. The permit shall be posted in a visible location on the campsite.

Rules are as follows:

- Camp only where approved by Town personnel
- ONE car only per campsite
- ALL CAMPERS MUST HAVE A PERMIT
- Please leave your campsite as clean as you found it
- Check out time is 11:00 am on your last permitted day
- Pets allowed if on leash and under control at all times. You will be charged for clean-up if you do not take care of it yourself.

NO:

- Cutting of trees or shrubs
- Use of manual or power saws
- ABSOLUTELY NO BURNING OF GARBAGE IN FIRE RINGS. IT IS ILLEGAL
- Dumping of garbage. Use containers that are provided
- Exposed firearms, bows, fireworks, or explosives of any kind
- Washing of dishes or clothing in restrooms
- DO NOT BLOCK ANY ROADWAYS- VEHICLES WILL BE TOWED

QUET HOURS:

- Strictly enforced, 11:00 pm to 7:00 am.
- NO NOISE EMITTING EQUIPMENT
