Statement from Three Lakes Park Commission

Re: Proposing any change to parks belonging to the Town of Three Lakes, WI

The purpose of this statement shall be:

- 1. to clearly state the authority of the Three Lakes Park Commission to govern, manage, control, improve and care for all parks belonging to the Town of Three Lakes.
- 2. to inform all entities that changes relative to physical features or to intended uses or operations pertaining to any park properties belonging to the Town of Three Lakes, now or at any time in the future, must be approved by the Park Commission.

Let it be known, that the Three Lakes Park Commission, with its authority provided by Wisconsin Statutes (Chapter 27, ss27.08), must be contacted and made aware of any desire to make changes within the park system, be it in regard to any physical features or to policies, operations and intended uses. If the commission decides to entertain any proposals the authority will reside with the commission to set or enforce any stipulations or limits in regard to the scope and scale of any projects. In conclusion, the Park Commission appreciates and welcomes any ideas or proposals that aim to improve or upgrade park facilities but wants it to be clearly understood that no changes should be envisioned, proposed or publicized by any organization or entity without first consulting with the commission and that no work will be allowed without its approval.
